PRESCHOOL CHRISTMAS PARTY

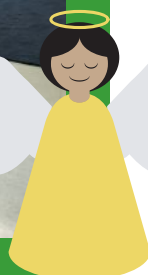

PUMPKIN FRENCH TOAST BAKE

Ingredients:

- 1 12oz Package Breakfast Sausage (precooked)
- 12 Eggs
- 1 Can 30oz Pumpkin Pie Mix
- 1 Can 12oz Evaporated Milk
- 1t Cinnamon
- 1t Vanilla
- 15 Slices White Bread, cubed



Instructions:

- Preheat oven to 350°
- Cut sausage into 1/4 inch rounds, in a very large bowl combine the sausage and cubed bread.
- In a large bowl, whisk eggs, pie mix, cinnamon, and vanilla.
- Add pumpkin mixture to bread mixture; stir to coat.
- Transfer to greased 13x9 baking dish.
- Bake uncovered for 35-40 minutes or until knife inserted into center comes out clean.
- Let cool and enjoy!
