## PRAYER BUDDIES

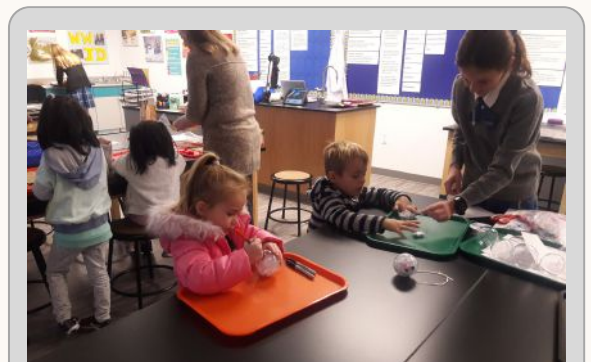

## COWBOY CORN CASSEROLE

### Ingredients:

- 4oz Cream Cheese, softened
- 1/2 C Milk
- 1/4 C Heavy Cream
- 3 T All-Purpose Flour
- 4 1/2 C Frozen Corn, defrosted
- 3 C Shredded Cheese, divided
- 10 Slices Bacon, cooked and crumbled
- Salt & Pepper to taste



### Instructions:

- Preheat oven to 350°
- In a large bowl, whisk cream cheese, milk, cream, and flour. Fold in corn, 2 1/2 cups cheese, bacon and season with salt and pepper. Sprinkle with remaining cheese and bake for 20 minutes.
- Let cool for 5 minutes and enjoy!
